ILWU CANADA SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

1. Applicants for scholarship must provide all of the following relevant documentation before acceptance into the ILWU Canada scholarship draw.
 - High School Transcripts - certified originals only.
 - Verification of acceptance into the program and a receipt showing monies paid.
 - A letter of good standing from the Local.
 - A letter of successful completion may be required.
2. The draw will be open to all applicants in programs from October 1st, of the previous year, to the draw deadline of September 30th, in the current year.
3. Successful candidates of the draw will not be entitled to apply for the following years scholarship.
4. The program must be identified either as a full-time vocational or career technical program which would include programs with work periods e.g. Co-op or apprenticeship.
5. The deadline for applications will be September 30th of the current year and the draw will take place at the next Executive Board meeting.
