### ILWU CANADA SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

1. Applicants for scholarship must provide all of the following relevant documentation before acceptance into the ILWU Canada scholarship draw.
  - High School Transcripts - certified originals only.
  - Verification of acceptance into the program and a receipt showing monies paid.
  - A letter of good standing from the Local.
  - A letter of successful completion may be required.
2. The draw will be open to all applicants in programs from October 1<sup>st</sup>, of the previous year, to the draw deadline of September 30<sup>th</sup>, in the current year.
3. Successful candidates of the draw will not be entitled to apply for the following years scholarship.
4. The program must be identified either as a full-time vocational or career technical program which would include programs with work periods e.g. Co-op or apprenticeship.
5. The deadline for applications will be September 30<sup>th</sup> of the current year and the draw will take place at the next Executive Board meeting.
